# DESIGNING THE KITCHEN IN A VILLA



Not all homes are the same. There are places that preserve history, art, and light. Places where every detail exudes elegance: marble floors, frescoed ceilings, period furnishings... In these spaces, the kitchen cannot be just any element: it must be a balanced project, capable of interacting with the beauty that surrounds it. **AURORA 1947** kitchens are designed for these homes. # KNOWING THE PLACE



Designing a kitchen in a period home requires a methodical approach that begins with a thorough architectural and historical analysis.

It's not just about taking measurements, but also decoding the home's language through the study of its decorative details—frescoes, wood paneling, stucco, floors, and original fixtures—to create a coherent palette of colors and materials.

This study allows for a design that harmonizes with the existing environment: the kitchen shouldn't impose itself as a foreign object, but should "dialogue" with the past through a respectful balance, avoiding jarring contrasts that would alter its identity.



# KNOWING THE CLIENT



Finally, the project takes shape through a thorough dialogue with the client.

It's necessary to distinguish between the different souls of the space — considering whether it's a formal kitchen or a space for everyday use — but, above all, **it's necessary to embrace the client's aesthetic vision.**

This is often interwoven with family memories and a strong connection to the home itself; elements that the designer must translate into functional solutions that honor the history of those who inhabit that space.

# ATTENTION TO DETAILS



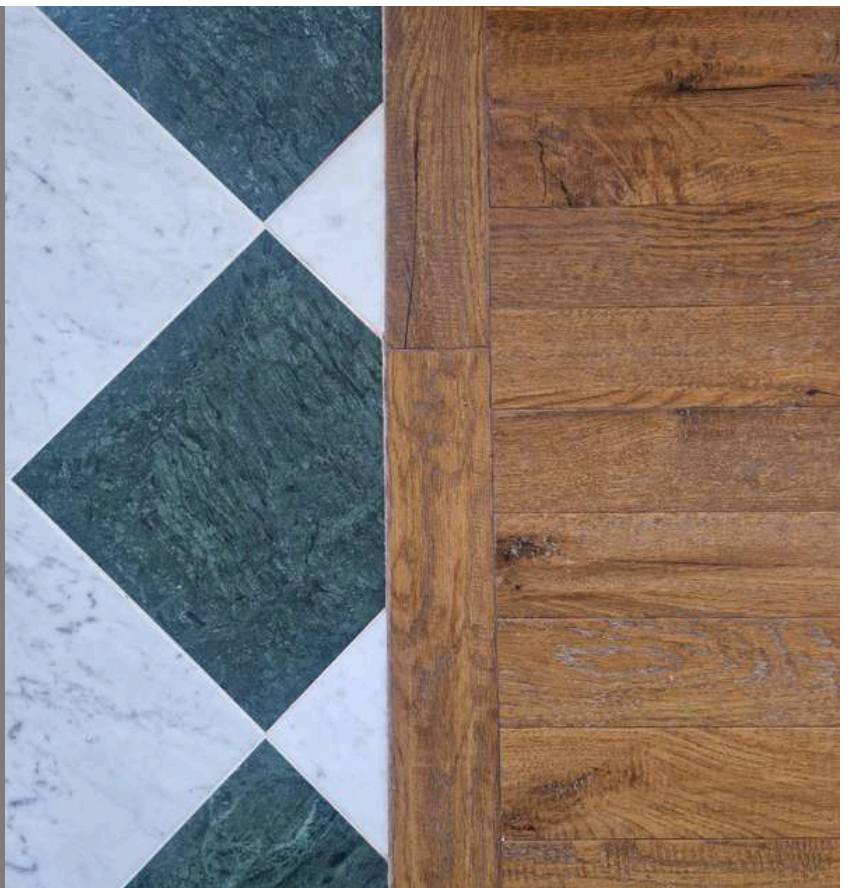

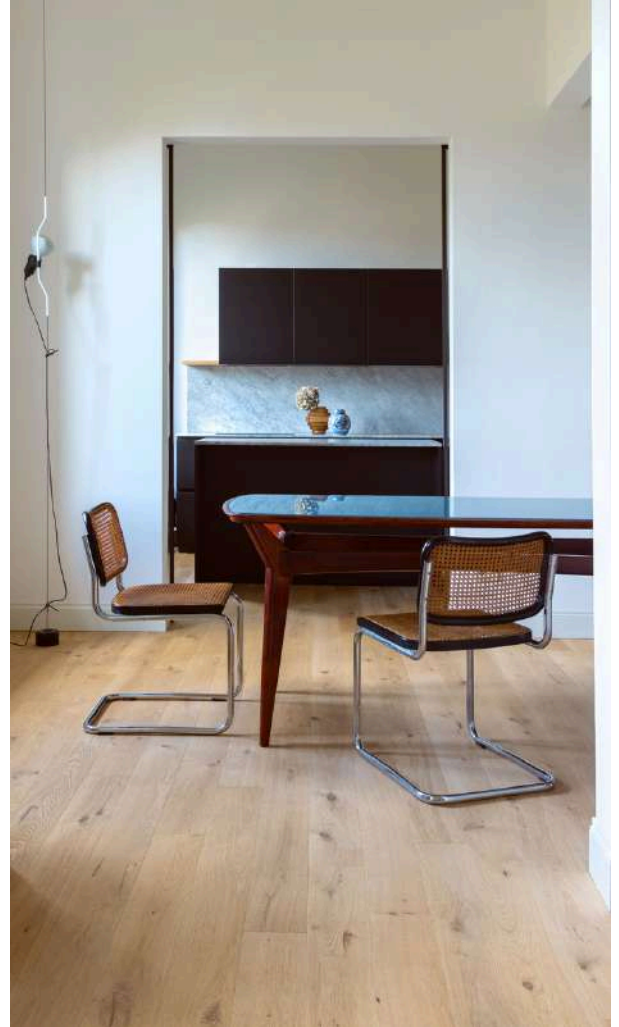


# AUTHENTIC MATERIALS



AURORA 1947's decades of experience and extensive knowledge of quality materials allow us to design with the utmost professionalism.

- We favor consistent materials, natural woods, noble stones, and authentic metals, avoiding imitations.
- Coordinate textures and shades with the home's original elements (marble, parquet, plaster, brass, wrought iron).
- Aim for a balance between aesthetics and function, because even in a stately kitchen, functionality must be essential, integrating elegant technical solutions such as concealed appliances or invisible countertops.
- Integrate contemporary technology discreetly, hidden, or camouflaged.
- Pay attention to the hues and color palette, favoring colors and materials that interact with antique plaster and marble, but also selecting contrasting materials while still creating a refined environment.

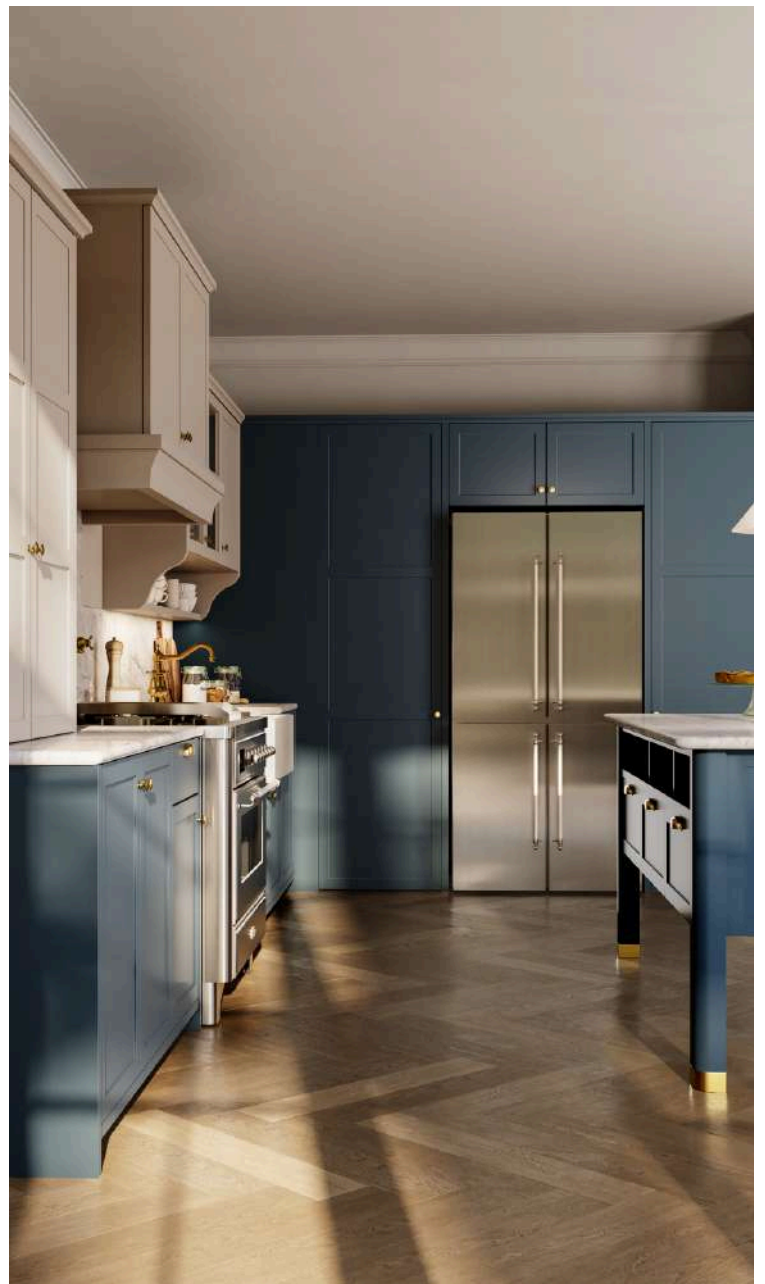


Timeless elegance and Shaker style perfectly balance the warmth of tradition with modern cleanliness.

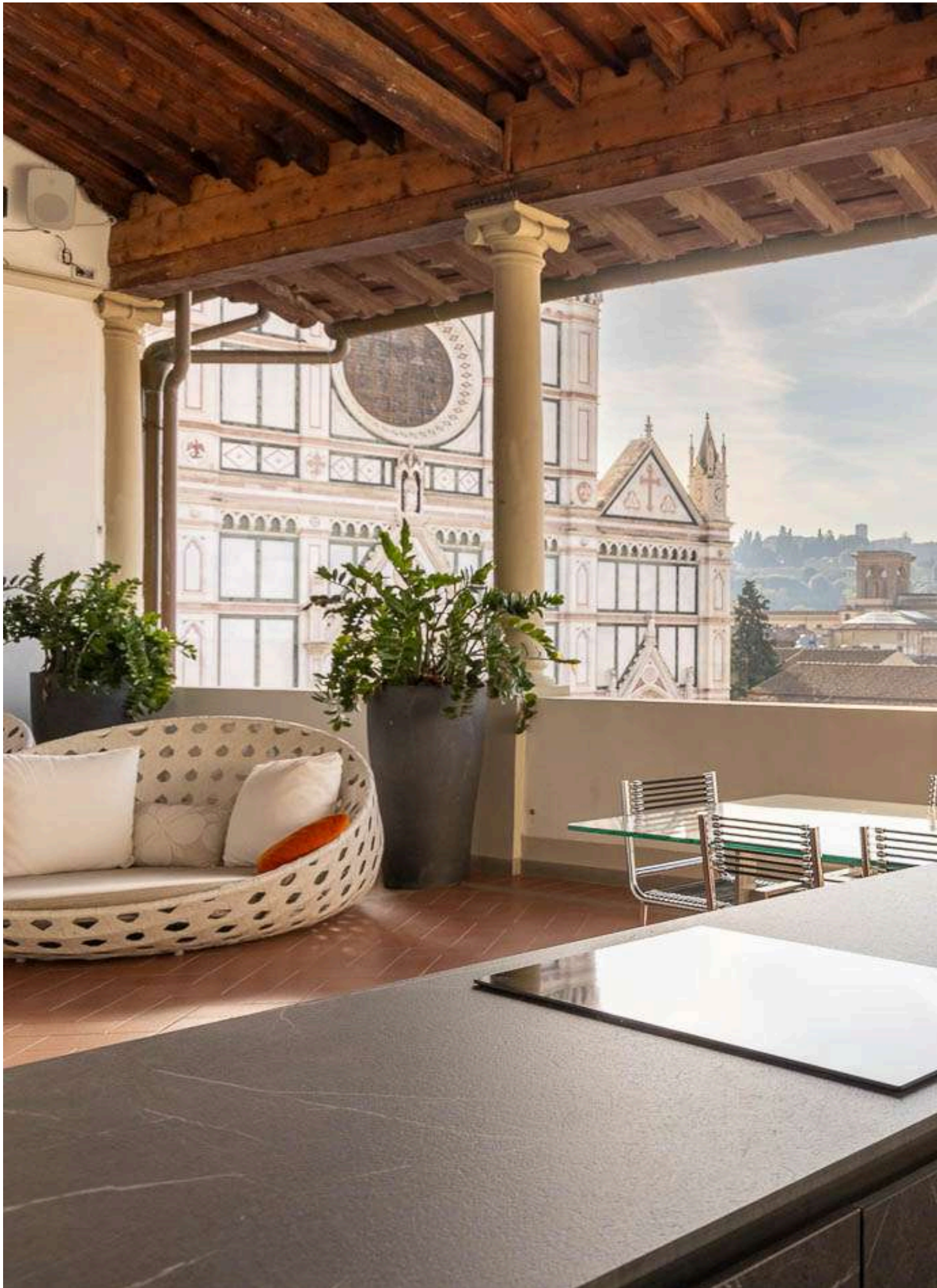

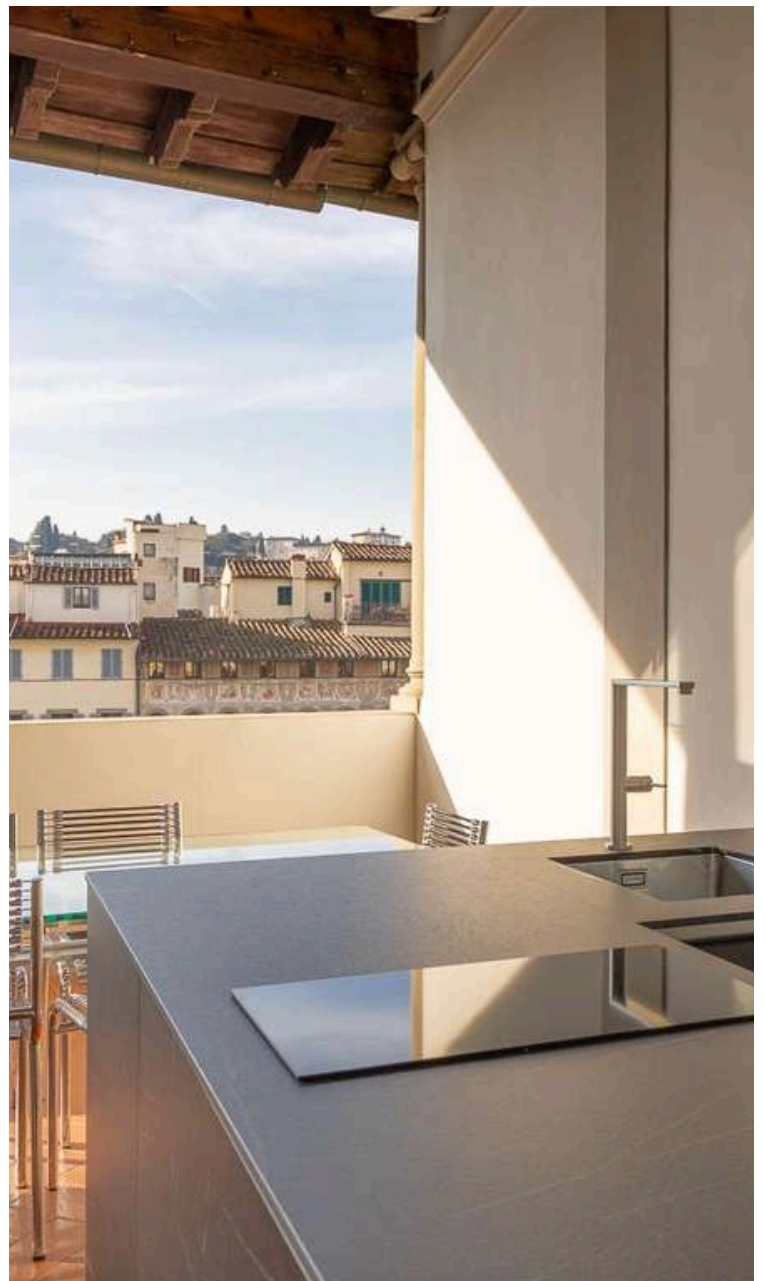

The furnishings are designed for comfort and functionality, creating a **welcoming and refined atmosphere** where you can enjoy a fine wine or simply relax while admiring the view.



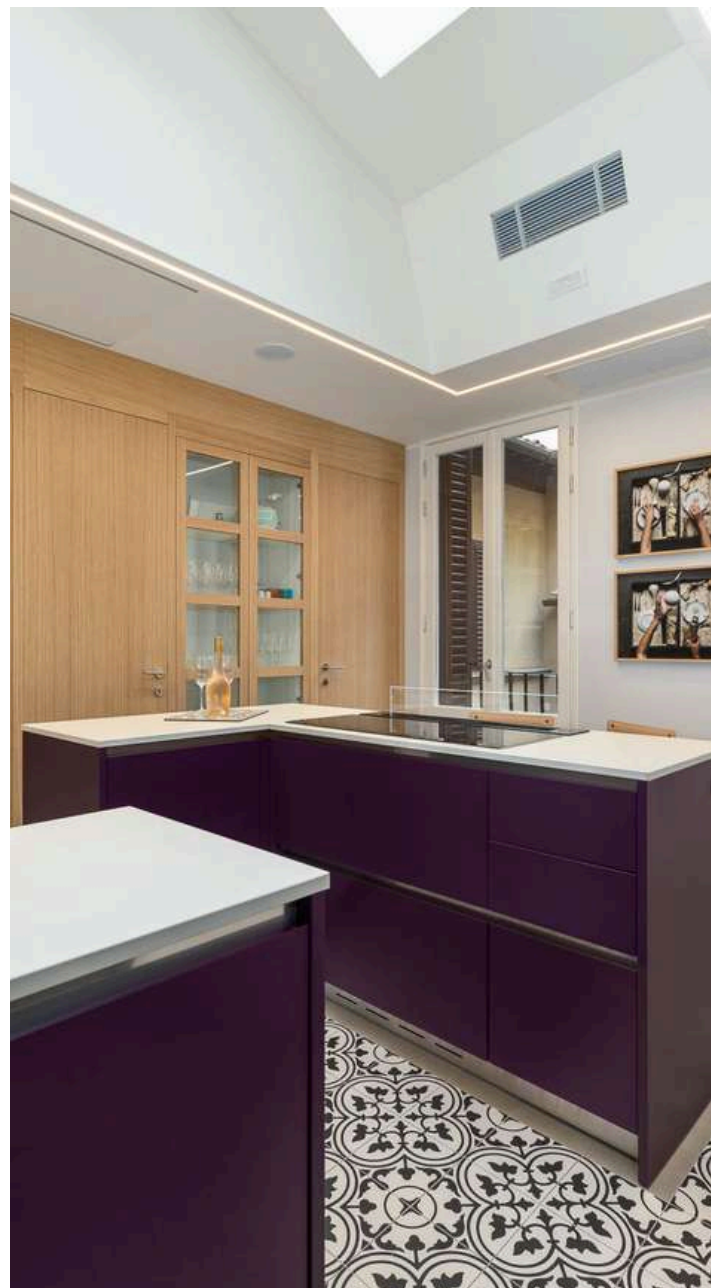

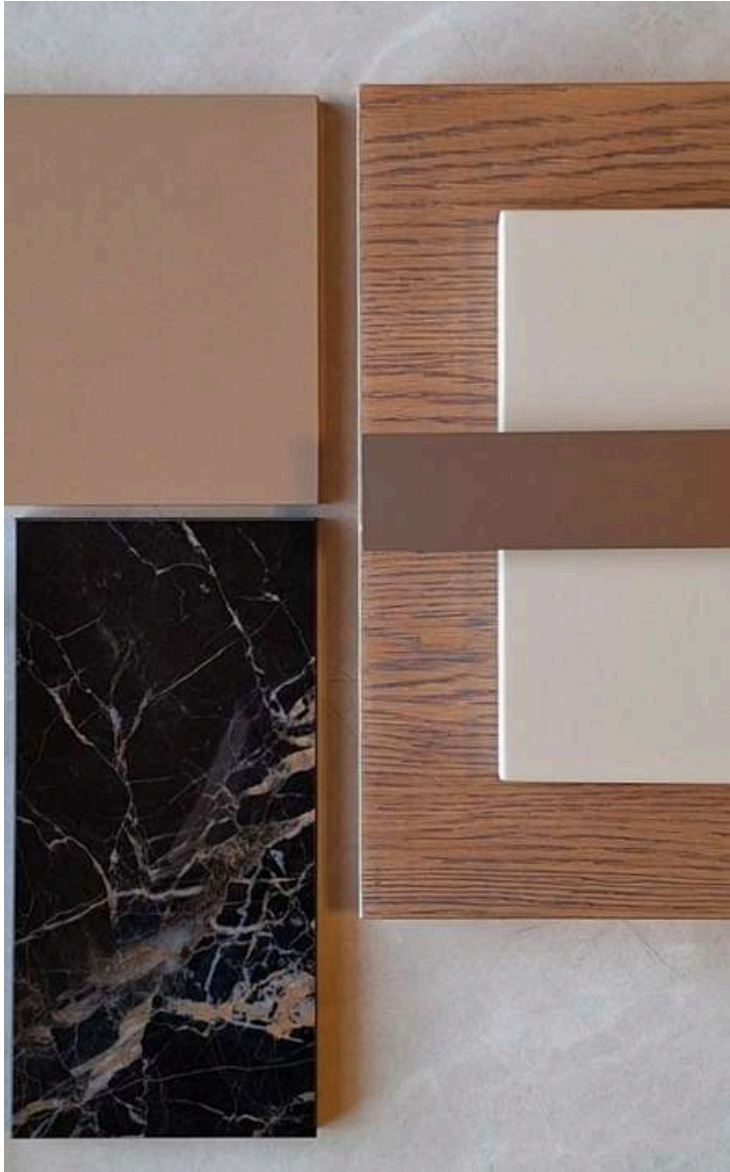
